ABS = absent from the round of play, Rd = Round, 3T4 = the participant played person numbered 3 and obtained a cumulative total of 4 points.

The 9<sup>th</sup> stage of the World Cup by the World Checkers Draughts Federation was played from 28<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> December 2015 at YMCA, Kampala, Uganda. The event lacked sponsorship and the host could not afford to meet the basic requirements such as accommodation and feeding of foreign guests and the prize money. This made the foreign players not to present themselves for the championship. UDF makes an appeal to government and companies to come to its aid and promote the game of draughts in the country. The championship was played in the memory of Nelson Mandela who was a keen draughts player and who attributed his leadership skill to the decision making and creativity skill he learnt from playing the game of draughts. The theme for the championship was "Draughts had one origin but evolved to supersede all forms of discrimination". Due to lack of funding, UDF was not in position to engage and make use of the

journalists, musicians and the general community to reflect on forms of discrimination within the World such as ethnic tensions, nepotism, child abuse, religious discriminatory practices, discrimination based on economic status, discrimination based on educational standards, discrimination based on body size, Apartheid and racism and other forms of discrimination within our communities.

This has been the first time that draughts has been played in Uganda for a duration of 4 days. On 28<sup>th</sup> December 2015, pool checkers draughts has played as a curtain raiser for the main event involving checkers. Twenty one (21) participants participated in the pool checkers tournament over nine rounds and was won by Sam Senoga (14 points), followed by Kamadi Musoli (14 points), Isaac Bafaki (13 points) and in 4<sup>th</sup> position was Mathius Mulumba.

Sixteen (16) participants took part in the checkers championship. The Gold medal was won by the year 2010 Uganda checkers champion Patrick Umala (from Iganga) with a total of 30 points. The silver medal was taken by Sam Senoga from Seeta with 29 points. The Bronze medal went to David Ochieng (from Iganga). This was the first time that Ochieng has taken part in not only a checkers but a draughts championship. There is therefore high hope that Ochieng is going to make a great checkers player. In 4<sup>th</sup> position was the reigning Uganda national checkers champion Dan Isabirye (from Makerere Univ) with 25 points. The best lady participant was Aidah Nauma from Makerere University and she obtained 13 points. The Guest of Honour for the closing ceremony was Hon. Medi Nsereko, the MP for Kampala Central.
